Entering Grades 7, 8 & 9

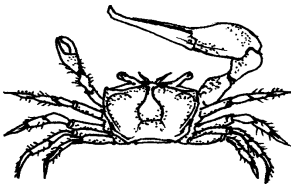
1 Session
