

## Mashpee Town Beach - 1960

As this 1960 aerial photograph (1) reveals, Mashpee Town Beach was once on Dead Neck and had a large bath house (yellow arrows) next to an ample parking lot. There were also two out buildings (blue) and an old oil tank from the building near the bath house. Wils Work Road is also clearly visible (red in 1, 3, 4), although the portion that went across Sage Lot Pond marsh and out along Dead Neck is less so (3, 4). Careful examination reveals two Wils Work Road houses on the shore of Waquoit Bay (1). Today, boulders still remain where the road crossed the marsh (red star in 4).
