**TIDAL Quest: Teens Investigating Diversity of Aquatic Life**

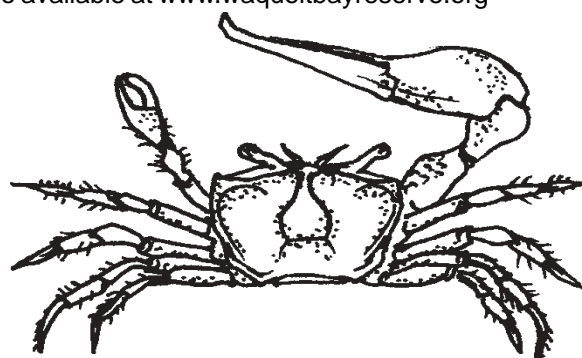
Grades 9 through 12 July 18 - July 22, 2011
