Chickens Aren't the Only Ones - We'll learn all about eggs and discover some of the animals that produce just one or two and some that lay millions of eggs at a time. Afterwards, a colorful egg hunt along the trail will reveal many local animals that begin their lives in an egg.

Where is Peter Cotton Tail? Hop on down the Flat Pond Trail in search of signs of our native New England Cottontail Rabbit. Learn what they need to survive and how they differ from the common Eastern Cottontails. Look for signs of spring along the boardwalks and bridges of this beautiful wetland trail. Walk 1 mile, prepare for wet ground in spots. Bring water and snack. Heavy rain cancels

Wildlife Walk- Explore beach, dunes and marsh in search of local wildlife and their signs including rare nesting birds and the many predators that they must try to avoid.
