- Plan for alternatives for exotic pets.
- Crate train and socialize dogs
- Know where you can go.
  - shelters, friends, hotels
- What if you are at work?







# Bring with you when you evacuate:



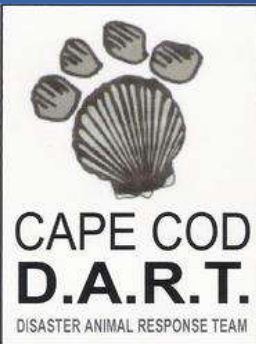
- Carrying case for small pets
- Collar, leash, harness
- ID tags, photos
- Pet food for 3 days
- Medications, medical records
- Immunization proof
- Photos
- Toys, bedding
